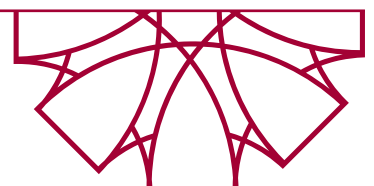

Quorum welcomes insurethebox

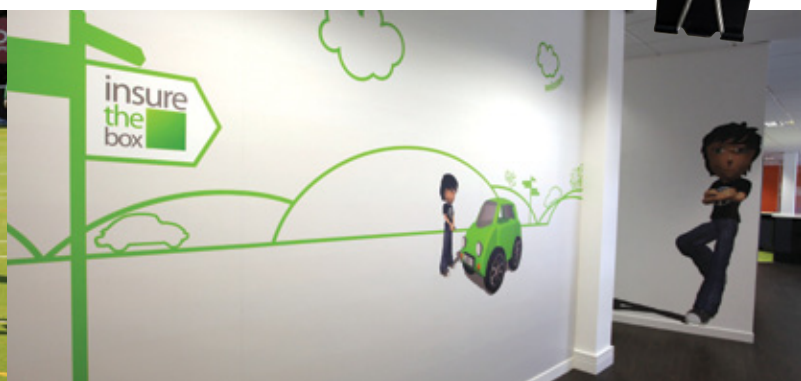
Motor insurers, insurethebox, have chosen the 13,500 sq ft top floor office of Q1 as the home for their North East based Service Centre.

All aboard express bus to Quorum



New and improved bus services

This June saw the completion of our second phase of major transport investment with a range of extended and new bus services running to the site. A total of 22 bus services now travel to the business park every hour - that's a near six-fold increase on bus-per-hour-frequency since October 2009.

Quorum Travel Co-ordinator, Laura Kerry, said: "The completion of the second stage of the park's transport plan is a key building block to Quorum's future. What we have had to ensure when building a business park of this size is that we create an integrated public transport service to match.

"After monitoring the demand for the Quorum Shuttle we decided to extend the service further into the park to give employees better access to their offices. Coupled with the additional Quorum Express services, this has helped create a first-rate transport infrastructure to the park.

"The new and improved services are a huge coup for this development, and we will continue to review the transport links for the growing number of people coming to the park".

The new Quorum Express services (Arriva routes X4 and X5/X6) operate from Haymarket to Blyth via Quorum, providing up to 6 buses per hour to/from Newcastle (taking less than 15 mins). The service provides more fast and frequent connections to the city centre. The new number 56 Arriva Service will also provide additional services to/from Quorum and Four Lane Ends especially benefiting those that work on evenings and weekends.

Quorum goes wild

Twenty volunteers from across the park swapped their jackets and briefcases for waders and wellies as our attempt to clean up the Letch and attract more wildlife got underway in June.

The 10-week programme, which involved removing the silt build-up in the stream behind the Q4 building to increase water flow, has not only resulted in making the area more attractive, but it is also hoped that it will increase the population of water vole in the area.

An extended wildlife programme, which will be carried out under the guidance of the Northumberland Wildlife Trust, is set to run from September and will involve a number of activities including; planting wild flowers, making and sighting nesting boxes and regular maintenance of the stream.

Kids 1st Quorum Charity Auction

In July, pre-school children from Kids 1st Quorum raised £767 for The Children's Foundation in a special art auction held at the nursery.

Children and staff at Kids 1st Quorum created the auction for the North East children's charity by making miniature pieces of art that were put up for auction in the nursery earlier in the month. To supplement the art work, the nursery also auctioned off prizes that were kindly donated by parents.

Andrea Venters, Nursery Manager, is absolutely delighted with the money that has been raised. She said: "This is the second auction of this kind that we have held at Kids 1st Quorum, not only does the money raised go to a good cause, but it also encourages our children to learn about the world around them, whilst having fun of course!"

Kids 1st Quorum is one of seven, soon to be eight, Kids 1st Nurseries across the North East of England. The nursery was purpose built to suit the needs of young children; outstanding features include a fingerprint security system and fully enclosed, exciting gardens for outdoor play.
